Synopsis of Evening Talk

The economic crisis of 2008 has made governance, risk management and compliance (GRC) a business priority. The bubble burst in 2008 was a chain reaction arising from the credit crisis, causing an implosion of the global economy. As the world fosters hopes of economic green shoots in 2009, those responsible for GRC will play major roles in transforming the corporate landscape to reduce the possibility for another such collapse.

The speaker will share with the audience global trends arising from GRC transformation efforts around the world. He will speak on risk standardization, increasing oversight, performance and risk management coordination, evolving expectations of corporate responsibility, and big shifts in GRC technologies.

Richard Chambers was appointed President and CEO of the Institute of Internal Auditors (IIA) in January 2009. He brings to this position 33 years of internal audit, accounting, and financial management leadership and 15 years of experience serving as an IIA volunteer and holding various leadership roles.
