The Board of Governors of IIA Singapore is pleased to invite you to attend an Evening Talk on The International Professional Practices Framework (IPPF).

Introduction

Given the pace of change in the global internal audit profession, The IIA Board established an international steering committee and task force to review the former Professional Practices Framework (PPF) and The IIA's guidance structure along with the related processes. Efforts were focused on reviewing the scope of the framework and increasing the transparency and consistency of the guidance's development, review and issuance processes. The results culminated in the new International Professional Practices Framework (IPPF).

On 1 January 2009, the IPPF came into effect replacing the former Professional Practices Framework (PPF or better known as the Red Book). Specifically, the purpose of the IPPF is to organize The IIA's authoritative guidance in a manner that is readily accessible on a timely basis while strengthening the position of The IIA as the standard-setting body for the internal audit profession globally. The IPPF is intended to assist practitioners and stakeholders throughout the world in being responsive to the expanding market for high quality internal auditing.



What is IPPF about?

The IPPF is the conceptual framework that organizes guidance promulgated by The IIA. It contains two types of guidance namely, Mandatory guidance and Strongly Recommended guidance.

Mandatory guidance includes The Definition of Internal Auditing, The Code of Ethics and The Standards. Mandatory guidance is intended to be applicable to both individuals and entities that provide internal auditing services. Strongly Recommended guidance includes Position Papers, Practice Advisories and Practice Guides. Whilst endorsed by The IIA, Strongly Recommended guidance is not mandatory and has been developed to provide a wide range of applicable solutions to meet the requirements of The IIA's Mandatory guidance.

The new framework clearly spells out what is mandatory and what is not; it is more transparent in terms of guidance development and providing practitioners with the guidance they need. Changes are concentrated in the areas of the scope of the framework and its structure, and enhancement to the processes for developing and maintaining guidance, and content enhancements including adding six new standards.....

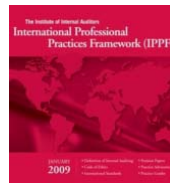
